OVERVIEW

CEHRO INDIA is an organization which directly benefits the unprivileged and neglected sections of the society, vigorously working towards bringing a change, and realizing their dreams of living a respectful and dignified life with basic needs, proper health care and education to all. Since 2012 we are serving the unprivileged section in Munirka Village and nearby slums. This year also, we worked for underprivileged section, reaching 210 underprivileged children through education development and poverty-fighting development programs. The projects running are Education, Health and Employment. We place special emphasis on investing in educating underprivileged children because our seven years of experience shows that their education support benefits the whole community because due to low literacy rate they used to worked as daily wage earners such as rag pickers, washers, etc to earn their daily bread and butter as a result they are suffering to feed their family as well as facing difficulty to provide the family with daily basic necessities in their life. Our main focus is to defeat illiteracy and to provide critical skills. Besides, we also make sure to provide health, nutrition, education and vocational training facilities to fulfil their dreams. We strengthen the independence will of the children; understand their individual interest and capabilities as each and every child are unique.





OUR PROGRAMMES

Initiative running and its achievement during 2018-2019

- Udaan (Early Childhood Programme):
 This year we were able to reach around 100 children under this programme. This year Early Childhood Program has benefited mostly children from 3-6 years.
- Kati Patang (Alternate Path for children out of school): We aim to bring back dropouts after Grade 5 to formal education system. The 40 beneficiaries under this programme benefitted during the year.
- Padho Padhao Programme: Before there was a difference between the student's age and class but now we have managed to bridge that gap. Now children are able to understand the curriculum of their present classes.

- Health Programme: This year we cover 210 underprivileged children studying in our centre. With the help and cooperation of our food partners (Responsenet), Individual Partners and via The Shared Birthday Project we managed to look after health nutrition programmes for our kids.
- Extra & Co- Curricular Activities:
 Underprivileged children made number of quilling products through training provided by our team. Here our children are working very hard, made their handmade products and sell their stuffs for their education support.

Workshop, Celebrations & Special Programmes

71st Independence Day Celebration: We celebrated 71st Independence Day with 300 children studying in our centre.

TCNS Partnership & Children's Day Celebration in the office of TCNS Clothing Co.: Became partners with TCNS and on the occassion of Children's Day the staff of TCNS Clothing has arranged the stage for the children of CEHRO INDIA to perform dance and also arranged a space for the stall for selling quilling products made by children to get some exposure.



Special Summer Programme: This year over 200 children joined CEHRO INDIA during The Special Summer Programme and gave marvellous performances and improvement in the extracurricular activities.

FEED THE HUNGER INITIATIVE

We have started with this initiative in serving food to the poor people targeting mainly the slum areas such as Ekta Vihar and Sonia Camp in R. K. Puram. We choose this area because it is nearby to our organization and from our observation we found that a staggering population in this area go hunger every day. Under this initiative we provide foods like- Biryani, Healthy vegetable Oats, Fruits, etc.

Our underprivileged children studying in our centre come forward and volunteering themselves and taking this initiative into their own hand in distributing food to the poor people. All the volunteers and other participants were satisfied after serving food to the poor people and spending time with them, laugh with them and most importantly feeding them. We thanked all the volunteers and our food partners for making this drive successful.
