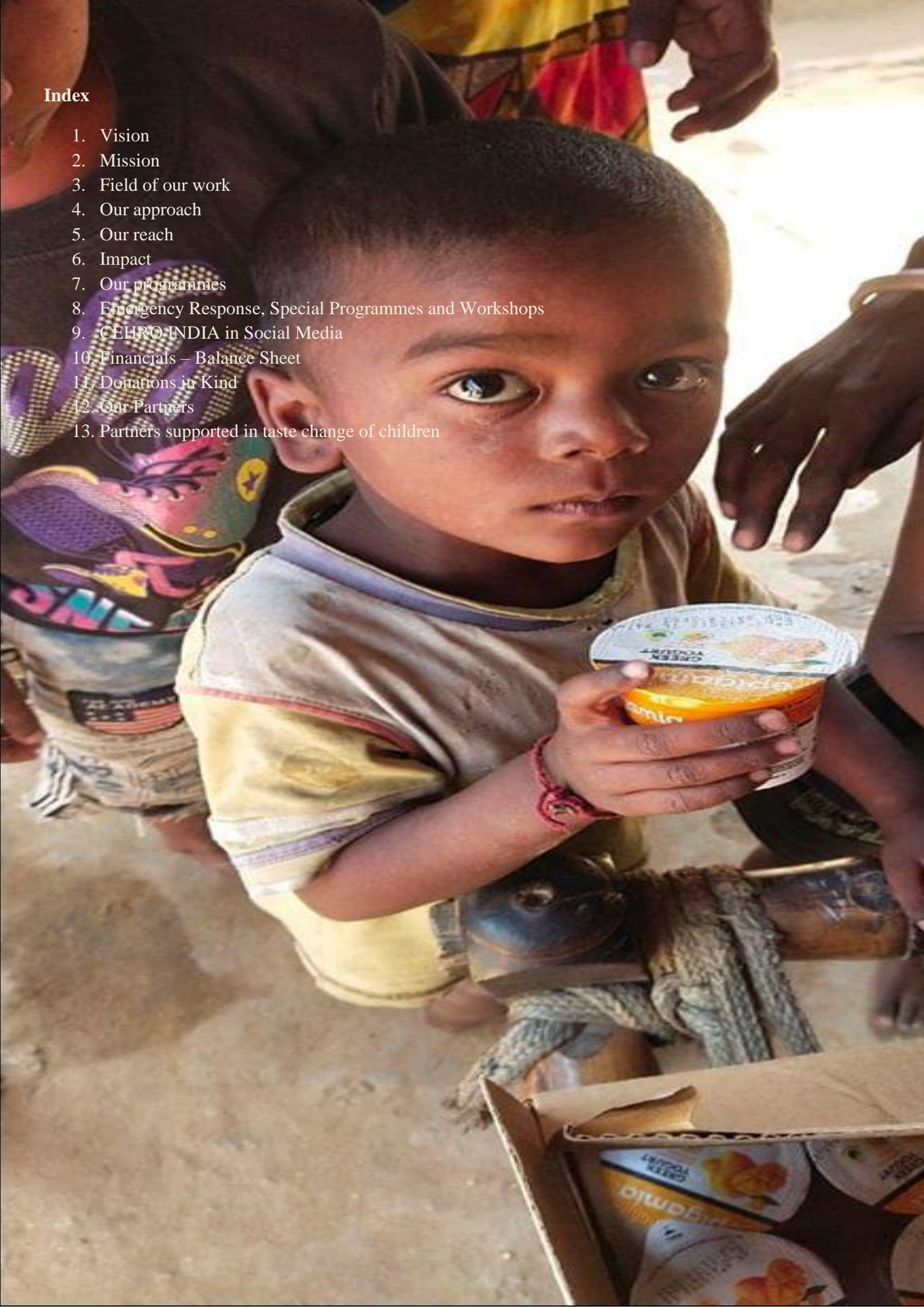

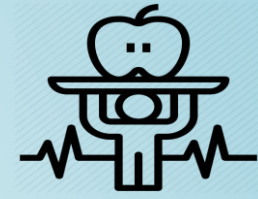
By 2030 every migrant poverty affected child in Munirka and nearby slums will be given an inclusive, supportive and progressive environment so that s/he can grow to the full potential.

Our Approach

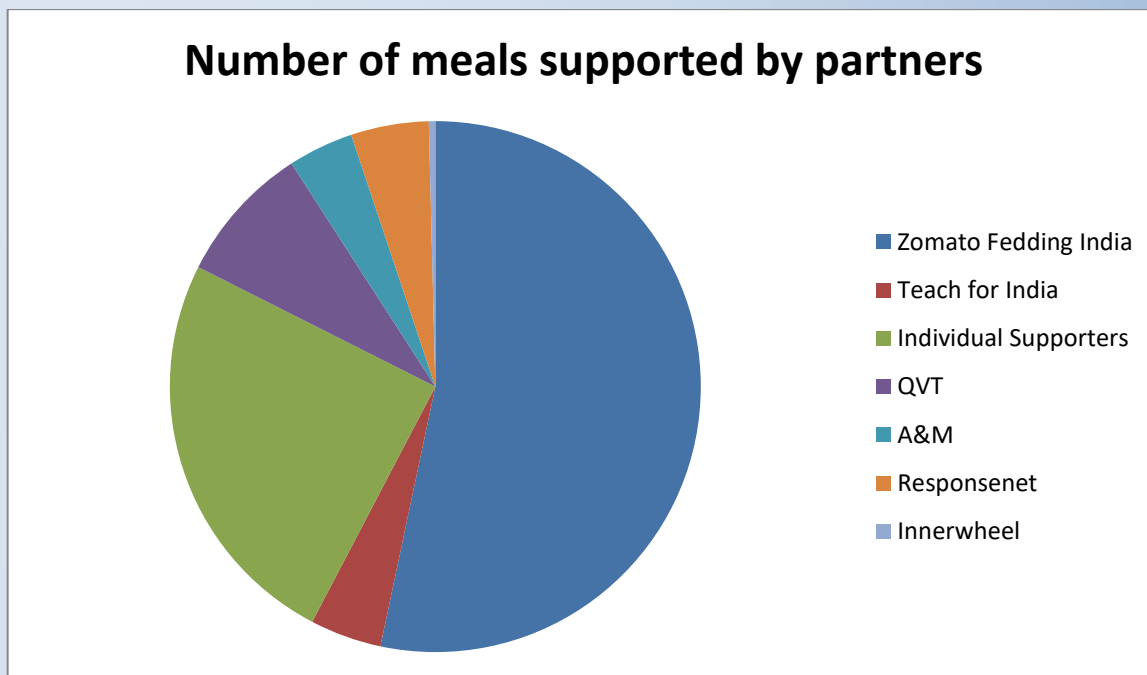
We primarily serve the migrant families who are critically poor with annual income of less than 1 lac. Children from these families are mostly first generation learners and are deprived of basic needs. We act as a catalyst focusing on the child centred solutions primarily derived from the community. More than disrupting the system, we focus on aiding the development by availing them the setup inside the community and facilitating growth of the change agents.

Our centre runs programs which are specially tailored according to the existing needs. In addition to that, we deeply value the creation of sense of responsibility among children. In order to convert our children into change agents so that they work towards community transformation, we provide them ample access and exposure, leadership opportunities and push them to take their own initiatives.



Our Reach

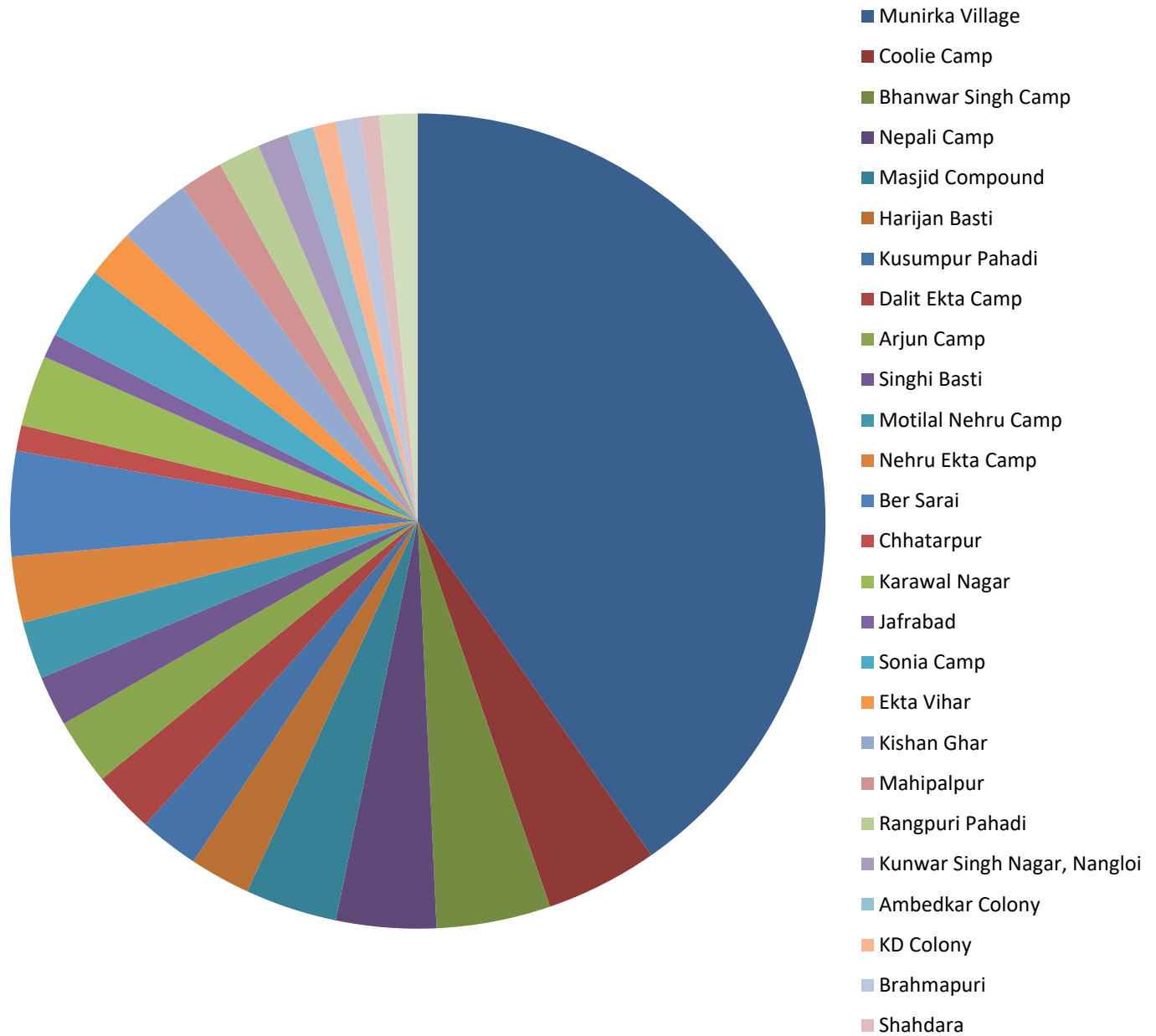
In the year 2020-21, CEHRO INDIA has distributed total **9, 49, 350** meals to the daily wage labourers with the help of our partners and individual donors.

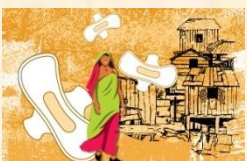

Our Programmes

Under Education

Udaan (Early Childhood Programme): This programme is intended to enrol children with age group 3-6 years from the community and engage them in several activities so as to prepare them to school.

Kati Patang (Alternate Path for children out of school): We aim to bring back dropouts after Grade 5 to formal education system.

Padho Padhao Programme: Before there was a difference between the student's age and class but now we have managed to bridge that gap. Now children are able to understand the curriculum of their present classes.

Under Health

Health & Hygiene: In this programme, we evaluate health, nutritional intake and hygiene habits of children. With the help and cooperation of our food partner Resposenet, Individual Partners and via The Shared Birthday Project we managed to look after health nutrition programmes for the children of CEHRO INDIA.

Under Employment

Saksham (Employment through Skill Development): We aim to support youth to develop skills required to get a job opportunity by short term courses. Underprivileged children made number of quilling products through training provided by our team and sell these products.

Under Emergency Response

Ration Distribution to daily wage labourers: In the backdrop of the coronavirus (Covid-19) scare affecting the livelihoods of daily wage earners, with the help of individual supporters and our partners we have been able to provide dry ration kits in 27 slums of Delhi.

Emergency Response, Special Programmes and Workshops

Dry Ration Distribution

Our beneficiaries are daily wage labourers who work as sanitation workers, rag pickers, domestic help and some of them beg for their living. These families do not have ration cards either so as to receive ration from nearby fair price shops.

The dry ration kit includes flour, rice, pulses, potato, onion, salt, mustard oil, spices etc.

We followed a strict procedure to distribute ration. Our team of 50 people visited different slums to survey for the neediest families and after identifying, they distributed tokens to these families by visiting their slum (Jhugis) so that crowd can be avoid for collecting rations and social distancing could follow.

We have provided more than 8 lakh meals to these families.





Taste Change

In effort to change the taste of underprivileged kids in deadly pandemic Covid-19 so that they feel motivated we are supported by Delhi Commission for Protection of Child Rights (DCPCR) who provided Kesar Badam Milk, Good Day and Parle-G Biscuits, Amul Milk, B-natural Juice, Horlicks, Cornflakes and from Zomato Feeding India we got Kinderjoy, Crunchy Muesli and Epigamia Yogurt, Alpenliebe toffees, Cornitos, Peanut butter, Unibic cookies and from Responsetnet we got Cold coffee, B-natural juice, Amla bar, Chocolate chip cookies

Fruits Distribution

With the support of A&M and Responsetnet we were able to distribute fruits to 315 underprivileged children in Munirka Village.



Menstrual Hygiene

Provided Paro sanitary pads to 8000 girls and ladies of 8-10 slums of Delhi with the support of individual donors and Delhi Commission of Protection of Child Rights (DCPCR).



Workshops

Conducted online art & craft workshops like cootie catcher, DIY badge, paper bag, honeycomb ball etc in collaboration with Kiran Nadar Museum of Arts at Bhanwar Singh Camp and Nepali Camp slum so that learning could not stop and such 80 workshops are done in corona time.



With constant art & craft virtual classes children learned by themselves. Therefore, we presented them with Ludo & Snakes and Ladders board game for outstanding performance.



Winter Clothes Distribution

Warm Clothes were distributed to 400 underprivileged children at Munirka Village, Priyanka Gandhi camp, Bhanwar Singh camp and Nepali camp with the support of individual donors and QVT Advisors Pvt Ltd.

500 lunch boxes were distributed in 3 different slums by Zomato Feeding India and RCD Regency Next.

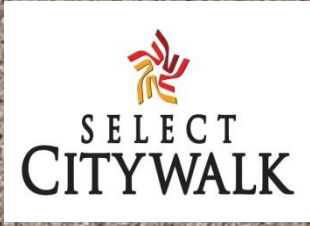
